- International collaboration

- Organization of seminars, theme days and excursions to interesting industrial sites
- The society awards the best domestic research publication on tribology yearly

 - Tribology of machine elements (modelling and experiments) – Failure and wear analysis – Fretting – Heavy abrasive wear – Impact wear – Wear simulation – Coatings
- Aalto University:
 - Tribology of machines – Tribology of materials – Biotribology – Tribology of vehicle engineering
- Metropolia:
 - Material research – Failure analysis – Welding
